# **Brantley Pearce Memorial**

On August 28, 2010, 18 year old Brantley Pearce died in an automobile accident. Brantley's best friend, Miles Moorman also died in the accident.

Two other friends, Kim Frey and Kristen Terry, who were also in the car, were injured.

Karen Dean, Brantley's mother,

has established this Memorial in his name out of the pain caused by their loss, to benefit the ministry of Emergency Chaplains. Karen knows firsthand the kind of help a family needs during a time of loss and she wants others who are suffering in the midst of their crisis to be offered the hope and comfort that Emergency Chaplains provides. No one should ever be alone when something like this happens.

The purpose of the Brantley Pearce Memorial is to raise funds that will provide training for new chaplaincy volunteers. Our vision is to steadily increase the area covered by Emergency Chaplains and to help more people during times of crisis.

Our annual banquet is also a time to recognize individual responders for their exceptional service with the Brantley Pearce Memorial Award. Tonight, one Chaplain and one First Responder will be honored because of their dedication to caring for those in crisis.

#### Options to leverage your assets for Kingdom Impact through Emergency Chaplains:

#### **Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD)**

QCD is a direct transfer of funds from an individual retirement account (IRA) to a qualified charity. This distribution allows individuals aged 70½ or older to donate up to \$100,000 per year directly from their IRA to a charity without having to report the distribution as taxable income. This also would count towards satisfying your Required Minimum Distribution (RMD) for that year.

#### **Appreciated Securities**

Giving long-term, appreciated securities — such as stock — has a dual tax benefit. First, you are entitled to an income tax deduction for the full market value of the securities on the date of transfer (up to 30% of your AGI for gifts to public charities, or 20% to private foundations). Second, neither you nor the receiving charity recognizes and pays any capital gains on the transfer. This means the charity receives more money and you receive a higher income tax deduction.

#### Donor-advised fund (DAF)

The Edward Jones Charitable Gift Fund, a donor-advised fund, provides the potential for an immediate tax deduction for your irrevocable donation to the fund. In addition, you'll have the opportunity to advise on how the money is invested, when the funds are granted and which charities receive grants. Since the money is invested, you have the potential to grow your charitable impact over time. The higher level of ongoing control allows several benefits, such as:

- · The ability to evaluate charities over time
- · Share your giving values with loved ones
- · Leave a legacy of charitable giving.

### ...IN THE FIELD

Ministry to a Grieving Mother—A chaplain responded to a home where a woman had discovered her daughter had died unexpectedly. With no nearby family, the chaplain assisted in contacting out-of-town relatives and helped coordinate arrangements with a local funeral home. They remained with the mother for several hours, offering emotional and spiritual support, and ensured she would not be left alone in the aftermath of the tragedy.

**4-Year-Old Dies of Gunshot Wound**—Three chaplains were dispatched following a tragic incident involving a child who sustained a self-inflicted gunshot wound after finding a firearm in a backpack. One chaplain responded to the scene, while two others went directly to the hospital to support the family. Several adults and at least one other child were present in the home when the incident occurred. Chaplains provided emotional and spiritual care to those impacted by the tragedy, including family members and first responders.

**Unexpected Death at Home**—A 50-year-old woman was found deceased by one of her teenage children. A chaplain responded to care for the surviving husband and three teenagers, helping them make temporary arrangements until funeral plans could be finalized.

Our reach extended beyond first responder agencies as well— Emergency Chaplains managed the chaplaincy response for NC Baptists on Mission in Durham. Following Tropical Storm Chantal, volunteers completed mud-outs on more than 100 flooded homes. Our chaplains provided care and support for both families in crisis and the volunteers who served them.
